RE: Consideration of a second amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement to the Federally Funded Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program (CDBG-MIT).

SUMMARY:

The Police Department requests approval for Amendment Two to the Federally Funded Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Program (CDBG-MIT) Subrecipient Agreement (Agreement Number I0147), originally executed on February 11, 2022, with the State of Florida Department of Commerce (formerly the Department of Economic Opportunity).

This amendment includes renaming the department to the Department of Commerce as of July 1, 2023, and updates the total funding to \$228,930.30. It also incorporates changes to comply with E-Verify system requirements for employment eligibility verification. Key updates involve modifications to Attachment A (Project Description and Deliverables) and Attachment G (Reporting Requirements), ensuring compliance with federal regulations. The amendment specifies the allocation of funds for hardening the Palm Bay Main Police Station, including roof replacement and hurricane shutter installation. The approval of this amendment will ensure continued support for this critical infrastructure hardening project.

Fiscal impact of the project resulted in the removal of the generator replacement (\$379,778.00) and the addition of (\$4,457.30) to the storm shutter replacement for a new total of (\$228,930.30) from (\$604,251.00). Budget Amendment forthcoming with the changes once the amendment is approved.
