RE: Consideration of the School Resource Officer Program agreement with Pineapple Cove Classical Academy (Lockmar) for the 2024-2025 school year.

SUMMARY:

Attached is an agreement between Pineapple Cove Classical Academy – Lockmar (located at 720 Emerson Dr NE) and the City of Palm Bay for a School Resource Officer (SRO) program during the 2024 – 2025 school year. This agreement provides for the availability of Palm Bay Police Department (PBPD) to provide an SRO through the Police Department's Off Duty Detail program in the event the school's assigned School Security Specialist from the Brevard County Guardian Program is unavailable. The agreement includes an exhibit which outlines the goals of the School Resource Officer program.

This agreement shall be effective August 12, 2024, with an expiration date of May 27, 2025.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact for this agreement. In the event the Palm Bay Police Department Off Duty Detail program is utilized, payment for the detail will be recorded as a reimbursement to the respective divisions off duty detail line item (1411) and administrative fees from that detail will be recorded in Special Detail Revenues (G/L Account# 001-0000-342-1005).

Motion to approve and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement with the Pineapple Cove Classical Academy – Lockmar for the School Resource Officer program for the 2024 – 2025 school year.
