Program Description: On March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law by the President. Section 9901 of ARPA amended Title VI of the Social Security Act (the Act) to add section 602, which establishes the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, and section 603, which establishes the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (together, the Fiscal Recovery Funds). The Fiscal Recovery Funds are intended to provide support to state, local, and tribal governments (together, recipients) in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 on their communities, residents, and businesses. The Fiscal Recovery Funds build on and expand the support provided to these governments over the last year, including through the Coronavirus Relief Fund (C.R.F.).

The American Rescue Plan will deliver \$350 billion for state, local, territorial, and tribal governments to respond to the COVID-19 emergency and restore jobs. The Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds provide a substantial infusion of resources to help turn the tide on the pandemic, address its economic fallout, and lay the foundation for a strong and equitable recovery. Recipients may use Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to:

On October 1, 2022, the City of Palm Bay, Florida, a municipal corporation herein referred to as "City" and Community of Hope, Inc. hereinafter referred to as the "Subrecipient," entered into an agreement American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Section 9901 of ARPA amended Title VI of the Social Security Act (the Act) to add section 602, which establishes the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, and section 603, which establishes the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (together, the Fiscal Recovery Funds). The Fiscal Recovery Funds are intended to provide support to state, local, and tribal governments (together, recipients) in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 on their communities, residents, and businesses. The Fiscal Recovery Funds build on and expand the support provided to these governments over the last year, including through the Coronavirus Relief Fund (C.R.F.). WHEREAS, Section 25 of the Agreement provides that the City or Subrecipient may amend this Agreement at any time provided that such amendments make specific reference to this Agreement, and are executed in writing, signed by a duly authorized representative of each organization. Such amendments shall not invalidate this Agreement, nor relieve or release the City or Subrecipient from its obligations under this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Subrecipient wish to amend the agreement as set forth herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and the Subrecipient do mutually agree as follows:

- I.** Habitat for Humanity of Brevard County, Inc. officially changed their agency name. The amendment will reflect the name change from Habitat for Humanity of Brevard County, Inc. to Space Coast Habitat for Humanity, Inc.

- III.** This Agreement may only be amended or extended by a written instrument executed by the City Manager and the Subrecipient expressly for that purpose.
- IV.** All other terms and conditions remain in effect.

1. Description of Project:

Habitat for Humanity of Brevard County, Inc. will utilize APRA funding to increase the inventory of affordable housing within the City of Palm Bay by building 5 single-family homes. The affordability is for 20 years. This funding will focus on developing the parcels to begin construction on these single-family homes.
