<b>RE:</b>	<b>Consideration of submitting a grant application with the Florida Digital Service, a part of the Florida Department of Management Services for funding to maintain previously awarded cybersecurity capabilities.</b>

### **SUMMARY:**

On April 20, 2023, City Council authorized the City Manager to execute a grant agreement with Florida Digital Service, a part of the Florida Department of Management Services (FLDS) related to the Cybersecurity Grant Program. The competitive grant program provided \$30 million from the State's Fiscal Year 2022-2023 to equip local governments with cybersecurity capabilities and technical assistance. Recently, the State appropriated \$40 million to fund year 2 of the program. Staff is requesting Council's consideration to apply for year 2 funding to maintain the current cybersecurity capabilities. There are no match requirements.

Information related to the City's security network infrastructure is exempt pursuant to Florida Statutes section 119.0713(5)(a)(1), 119.071(d)(1)(f), and 282.318.
