RE: Ordinance 2024-12, amending the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 110, Business Taxes, Subchapter 'Business Taxes; Tax Receipts; Receipts', by including a zoning compliance requirement prior to the issuance of a Business Tax Receipt, final reading.

SUMMARY:

A public hearing is to be held on the above subject ordinance and the caption read for the second and final time at tonight's Council meeting.

Staff has prepared an amendment to Palm Bay Code of Ordinances, Chapter 110, Business Taxes, Tax Receipts, Receipts. Specifically, staff is proposing to amend Chapter 110 as follows:

§ 110.28 PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS BEFORE ISSUING BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT added reference of zoning compliance and deleted additional requirements.
