RE: ****Z24-00004 – Rezoning from RM-10 to RM-15 Citywide (Ordinance 2024-45) - City of Palm Bay, Brevard County, Florida, amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Palm Bay by changing the zoning of all RM-10 (Single-, Two-, Multiple-Family Residential) zoning district properties to RM-15 (Single-, Two-, Multiple-Family Residential District); providing for a change of the Zoning Map; providing for an effective date**

SUMMARY:

Ordinance 2024-33 was adopted by the City Council on September 19, 2024, to bring the land development regulations into compliance with the Palm Bay Comprehensive Plan and create an updated Land Development Code. The Ordinance also eliminated the RM-10, Single-, Two-, Multiple-Family Residential Zoning District. As such, the subject parcels, consisting of approximately 361 acres, must be rezoned to a zoning district that is most compatible with the former RM-10 district; and, consistent with the High Density Residential Future Land Use designation.
